### **RALLY:**

Veterans: Novice, Advanced, Excellent: Classes will have no jumps, a maximum number of 10 stations, and a maximum of 2 stationary exercises for each course. There would be no the sit/stay station requirement for Excellent as well. Dogs eligible to enter are at least 8 years old, may not have earned a Q above the level they enter, and are not entered in any regular classes. Tie scores will be broken by times running the course.

Masters class: Excellent level class with no limit on the number of Adv/Exc stations on the course, no limit on the number of stationary exercises, will have 3 jumps, and up to 25 stations. There will be no course maps and no walk-throughs. Handlers will be sequestered while the course is built and will be called upon one by one to get their dog and run the course. After running the course, handlers will be seated in a certain section of the gallery and will not be able to interact with the handlers who have not yet run the course. Dogs having RE title or above may enter this class. Tie Scores will be broken by times running the course
